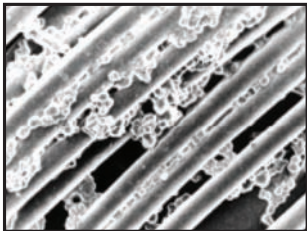

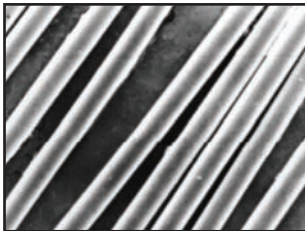
Before disinfection
